# Deck Ten on Explorer of the Seas®

## SUITE/DELUXE

### RS Royal Suite

Separate bedroom with king-size bed, private balcony with hot tub, whirlpool bathtub, living room with queen-size sofa bed, baby grand piano, and concierge service. (1,188 sq. ft., balcony 170 sq. ft.)

### OS Owner's Suite

Queen-size bed, private balcony, separate living area with queen-size sofa bed, private bathroom with bathtub, separate shower and bidet, and concierge service. (506 sq. ft., balcony 64 sq. ft.)

### GS Grand Suite

Two twin beds (can convert into queen-size), private balcony, sitting area (some with sofa bed), and concierge service. (381 sq. ft., balcony 95 sq. ft.)

### JS Junior Suite

Two twin beds (can convert into queen-size), private balcony, private bathroom with bathtub and a sitting area. (277 sq. ft., balcony 69 sq. ft.)

## BALCONY

### D1 Superior Oceanview Stateroom

Two twin beds (can convert into queen-size), private balcony, sitting area and a private bathroom. Rates vary from deck to deck. (215 sq. ft., balcony 50 sq. ft.)

### E1 Deluxe Oceanview Stateroom

Two twin beds (can convert into queen-size), private balcony, sitting area with sofa, and a private bathroom. Rates vary from deck to deck. (173 sq. ft., balcony 47 sq. ft.)

## INTERIOR

### L Interior Stateroom

Two twin beds (can convert into queen-size), sitting area with sofa, vanity area, and a private bathroom. (160 sq. ft.)
