



Curu Reserve: Spend a morning exploring the Curu National Wildlife Refuge—a private reserve of which two-thirds is preserved as primary forest.

**Tortuga:** Characterized by palm-fringed beaches and lush tropical flora, Tortuga is pretty and peaceful and offers terrific sheltered swimming and snorkeling in warm waters.

Bahia Drake: Lush rainforest in the main attraction. Cross the river on a swing bridge and hike along flower lined paths.

Isla Coiba: One of Panama's National Parks, this gorgeous island has pristine white sand beaches and is your private sanctuary for the day.
